



## IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO ALL PARTICIPANTS

As of February 1, 2023, local authorities are imposing new rules for entry into Qatar.

Every traveler must have a health insurance certificate covering medical care.

### **An international insurance contract is valid if the policy covers:**

1. Emergency medical treatment:  
Up to QAR 150,000 for the policy period and within the State of Qatar.
2. Emergency medical assistance with a sub-limit of QAR 35,000, includes:
  - Emergency ambulance transportation within the State of Qatar, and where necessary.
  - Medical evacuation to the individual's country of residence.
3. COVID-19 and Quarantine:
  - a) Sub-limit up to QAR 50,000.
  - b) Covid-19 treatment for positive cases.
  - c) Quarantine expenses (for confirmed cases) are up to QAR 300 per day.
4. No waiting period is required under this document.
5. Repatriation: In the event of the visitor's death within the State of Qatar, the cost of repatriation is covered up to an amount of QAR 10,000.
6. No copayment or deductibles required for any covered services as per the terms and conditions stipulated in the visitor's health insurance policy.
