

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO ALL PARTICIPANTS**

As of February 1, 2023, local authorities are imposing new rules for entry into Qatar.

Every traveler must have a health insurance certificate covering medical care.

## An international insurance contract is valid if the policy covers:

- Emergency medical treatment:
  Up to QAR 150,000 for the policy period and within the State of Qatar.
- 2. Emergency medical assistance with a sub-limit of QAR 35,000, includes:
  - Emergency ambulance transportation within the State of Qatar, and where necessary.
  - Medical evacuation to the individual's country of residence.
- 3. COVID-19 and Quarantine:
  - a) Sub-limit up to QAR 50,000.
  - b) Covid-19 treatment for positive cases.
  - c) Quarantine expenses (for confirmed cases) are up to QAR 300 per day.
- 4. No waiting period is required under this document.
- 5. Repatriation: In the event of the visitor's death within the State of Qatar, the cost of repatriation is covered up to an amount of QAR 10,000.
- 6. No copayment or deductibles required for any covered services as per the terms and conditions stipulated in the visitor's health insurance policy.
